Justice Weaver is accepting applications for Summer 2008 internships (approximately May through August) in her Traverse City office.

Student interns participate in a variety of research and writing projects under the supervision of Justice Weaver's law clerks. These projects include reviewing lower court records, applications for leave to appeal, and draft opinions, reading parties' written briefs, and drafting case memoranda for the Justice's review. Depending on the students' abilities, they may also assist with the drafting of opinions. In addition, student interns travel regularly with Justice Weaver to many different events across the state, including oral arguments, weekly Court conferences, and judicial investitures, as well as various political events, committee meetings, and State Bar functions.

This is an unpaid internship, but it provides great experience, exposure, and invaluable career contacts. It also improves research and writing skills. We will work with your college or university to satisfy academic requirements.
